Concern A perfected and universal control of the spread of homosexuality

The General Assembly,

Knowing that biology has granted men and women with complementary features, allowing them to perpetuate the cycle of life,

Witnessing that the homosexuals are stealing our husbands, corrupting our sons and tearing our families apart, violating Article 16.3 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which states that "Family is the natural and fundamental element of society and has the right to be protected by society and the State",

Fearing that their public and vicious displays will pervert the souls of our good pious citizens, stripping away young boys' dignity and leading young girls to depravation and prostitution, contaminating the new generation in a way that is harmful to our society's values,

Realising that the illness of homosexuality directly contradicts our sacred texts – not only the Coran but also the Bible and the Torah - creating abhorrent conflicts with our religious institutions,

Decides to encourage other nations to draw inspiration from Poland and implement their resourceful methods to control the spread of this devious and diseased behaviour, thus achieving effective protection of the sacred values of family.

- By perfecting our methods of identification of those responsible for the perversion
- By developing an efficient and economical way to separate them from the normal citizens
- By reinforcing family values from a young age, ideally through public education
- By giving good inhabitants the opportunity to prove their loyalty by delating and apprehending the homosexuals to bring them to justice.
