

RESOLUTION III – HOLY SEE

THEME: POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

BETRIFT: ENTRY OF THE HOLY SEE AS A PERMANENT MEMBER OF THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Concerned at the global interference caused by the failure of the Security Council to take effective measures to maintain international peace and security,
- Deploring the gravity of world conflicts, such as the multiple revolts and armed clashes and massacres of people around the world,
- Alarmed by the quarrels within the Security Council itself who is made of permanent members who use their veto rights for personal ends and cannot manage to agree on important issues requiring immediate attention,
- Recalling that the Holy See's vocation is to pacify the people through daily prayer, love of one's neighbour and absolute obedience to the Pope who conveys the word of God on Earth,
- Insisting that the Holy See is the spiritual nation of billions of faithful who, before obeying the laws of a country, act according to the fundamental values of their religion,
- Commits the United Nations to accept the integration of the Holy See as a permanent member of the Security Council. Through its role as universal peacemaker, its neutrality in the current conflicts and its international influence, the Holy See will guide the rest of the Security Council towards the Lord's way, that is to say peace,
- Decides finally to replace the United States by the Holy See, the President having perverted his nation by propagating hatred rather than the love of his neighbour, a value necessary for the existence of a better world.
