THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Recalling the latest events in Iran,
- Saddened by the death of the General Quassem Soleimani, a general killed under the command of US President, Donald Trump,
- Frightened by the major risk of escalation and violent claims,
- Noting the fragility of the agreements between various Nations in this assembly, and more precisely between the Iranian and American delegation,
- Decides to support a message of world peace by asking to the Nations present today to condemn the acts of the United States of America facing the assassination of the General Soleimani thus implying;
- The condemnation of gratuitous and unjustified violence between states and members of the UN Assembly;
 - Less use of combat weapons of all kind worldwide;
 - Limited intervention in sensitive regions in order to guarantee political stability.
