

## RESOLUTION XV – DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA

THEME: CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN: THE PARTIAL NUCLEAR DISARMAMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Deploring a difference in the repartition of nuclear warheads around the world with more than 90% of bombs owned by the Russian Federation and the United States of America,
- Worried by the omnipresent pressure generated by this unfounded superiority,
- Outraged by the domination exerted by the Russian and American powers on the other states, which is only a painful reminder of a bygone era,
- Underlining the increased and absurd presence of nuclear bombs on the soil of states that have signed the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons, ratified with the aim of preventing the excessive production of warheads in the name of global security, a security ignored by the sur-nuclear states,
- Supporting an egalitarian and secure vision of the global future,
- Decides to create a fairer world for the states possessing nuclear weapons by limiting the number of authorized warheads to 300;
- to entrust the excess quantity of H and A bombs to the UN in order for them to be stored securely in a neutral and stable country;
  - to ratify a new treaty with the aim of suppressing the domination of these states and preventing any future overproduction of nuclear weapons.
