

# RESOLUTION XV – HOLY SEE

THEME : CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN : CREATION OF A SPECIAL STATUS FOR THE CITY OF JERUSALEM

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Worried by the instability caused by the Israeli-Palestinian conflict across all the Middle-East;
- Stressing the present situation, as of the recognition of Jerusalem as the capital of the State of Israel, most notably by the United States of America, is perceived as a provocation by many member states of the United Nations;
- Deploring the current situation where many countries have or are conceiving displacing their respective embassies in Jerusalem, State of Israel;
- Looking into a compromise for a lasting and stable peace between states;
- Pointing out that recognising Jerusalem as the capital of a Palestinian state and the State of Israel is conceivable and the reconciliation of these commonalties is the sole solution for a durable stability in the region;
- Reminding that multiculturalism, cohabitation and devotion to a worldwide peace are three important Christian values, shared with the United Nations Organisation;
- Regarding the Roman Catholic Church as an ancient and venerated institution, having always been a guardian of peace and tolerance and having always found the means to be heard and respected;
- Noticing the absence of objective of the Swiss military conscription, in the Swiss Armed Forces' current state;
- Requests the creation of a specific status for the city of Jerusalem, under a Holy See mandate, allowing the both states in conflict to establish the city as their political capital, ensuring to the House of the Holiness its former glory and holiness;
- Charges the Pontifical Swiss Guard, serving as the military of Vatican City, composed of soldiers of the Swiss Confederation military, country known for its neutrality and impartiality, of guarding the city of Jerusalem;
- Ensuring peace and prosperity in the region, in the name of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, dead for humanity, as "peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness" – James 3:18.
- Decides to found the organization "The Future is Ours," which is to supervise a pilot project on each continent (Smart Neighborhoods & Communities – SNC Project) to, then, widen the project to a planetary scale. These Eco-neighborhoods (progressively turning into Eco-cities) would benefit from the investiture of aeroponics in urban farms. Besides, they would participate in actions such as the zero-waste project, in which food and leftovers would be saved, for instance, or even better municipal wastewater collection system, featuring better purification and efficiency. This pilot project would be established and carried out in collaboration with other institutions and organizations. Finally, the emphasis is to be put on the principle of collective cohesion in regard to the communities, as much within the cities as in the rural areas.
