

# RESOLUTION XV – DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

THEME : SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

CONCERN : SMART CITIES (SMARTCITIES-SMARTLIFE) AS MODELS OF SUSTAINABLE CIVILIZATIONS IN THE FUTURE

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Conscious of an exponential demographic growth problem and the necessity to preserve and intelligently use resources allocated by the earth (both renewable and non-renewable), to get closer to a state of optimum equilibrium between needs, consumption, and reserves,
- Underlying the necessity to bolster an urban development that is modern and responsible, although its urgency, when it comes to the variety of problems encountered in the world's biggest cities, is not to be demonstrated anymore,
- Alarmed moreover, by the troublesome living conditions (especially regarding hygiene) of numerous citizens, as well as a substantial majority of human being throughout the world,
- Insisting the resolution adopted by the UN on the 22nd of June 2017 denouncing abuses and discriminations against women, but omitting the criminal character of abortion and implying the recognition of abortion as a method of family planning,
- Specifying the sustainable development goals to be achieved before 2030 :  
n°2: Avoiding food wastes  
n°6: purifying and preserving potable and clean water  
n°7: producing renewable and green energies  
n°8: decent work and economic growth  
n°9: innovating and developing industries and infrastructures  
n°11: founding sustainable towns and communities  
n°12: Producing and consuming responsibly  
n°13: implementing measures relative to climate change and the fight against it  
n°15: favoring and encouraging terrestrial life
- Decides to found the organization "The Future is Ours," which is to supervise a pilot project on each continent (Smart Neighborhoods & Communities – SNC Project) to, then, widen the project to a planetary scale. These Eco-neighborhoods (progressively turning into Eco-cities) would benefit from the investiture of aeroponics in urban farms. Besides, they would participate in actions such as the zero-waste project, in which food and leftovers would be saved, for instance, or even better municipal wastewater collection system, featuring better purification and efficiency. This pilot project would be established and carried out in collaboration with other institutions and organizations. Finally, the emphasis is to be put on the principle of collective cohesion in regard to the communities, as much within the cities as in the rural areas.
