

Resolution presented by the delegation of

Paraguay

Theme sustainable development

Concerns Improvement of water quality and waste management in Paraguay

The General Assembly,

preoccupied with our planet's well-being as well as the health of our people , about water pollution and recycling issues,

recalls the water pollution in Paraguay is 60,71 % while dissatisfaction with public garbage disposal is 71,43 % , and is far away from the international environmental goals,

stresses that we are destroying our world and we need to do something against it,

aware of the high level of pollution in the Paraguay waters and waste pollution,

decides to invite all states to aim at the introduction of the following acts in their legislation:

- 1. Permits for discharges directly in surface water and ground water:** industries as well as public and private facilities must obtain permits if their discharges of water go directly to the environment,
- 2. Water criteria for lakes :** Establish water criteria for lakes and rivers addressing 29 toxic pollutants with maximum levels that are safe for humans, wildlife and aquatic life,
- 3. Intensify recycling economy:** Introduce the recycling economy and produce new resources as well as limiting the waste. Communities that make good recycling, will be rewarded with tax relief.
