

RESOLUTION PRESENTED BY THE DELEGATION OF
ERITREA

THEME CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERNS THE CREATION OF THE UNION FOR A COMMON DEMOCRACY (UDC)

The General Assembly,

Noting that the primary purposes of the UN are to maintain international peace and security, and that democratic stability is essential to that end,

Observing that the countries in which leaders change regularly create unstable situations as a result of their political system, as the United States do with international organisations every 4 years, or as Great Britain did with Brexit,

Noticing that the effort to establish Western “democracy” has failed numerous times, whether in Afghanistan, in Libya, in Iraq, etc.

Reminding that the states with the highest GDP growth and the most stable population are the ones with long-standing leaders,

Admiring these European nations of which the richest have kept their leaders over an extended period of time. Indeed, the most consequential GDP of the region is Germany’s (with Angela Merkel having spent 16 years in power), and the biggest GDP per capita is that of the Luxembourg’s (with Jean-Claude Juncker having blessed the country for 18 years),

Inspired by the remarkable work of comrade Xi Jinping who has led his country into ethereal economic growth; by the glory Vladimir Putin has given to Russia; by their common tradition of long-standing leaders,

Outraged by the fact that the UN has no organisation in place aiming at creating stable and democratic political systems,

Decides to make the world great again by creating a specialised agency named UDC which will encourage a stable international order in our countries, most notably by:

- offering financial services to the countries who stop term limits
- establishing financial sanctions to those who do not.
