

Resolution presented by the delegation of the Russian Federation

Theme	Political and Social Rights
Concern	Creation of an international, high security prison in Siberia
The General Assembly,	
Alarmed	by the carceral overpopulation present in over 120 countries across the world including rich countries such as France and The United Arab Emirates where the prison occupation level greatly exceeds 100%,
Deploring	that this situation results in the violation of numerous human rights notably article 5 that dictates that no one shall be subjected to degrading treatment and 25 that states that everyone has the right to a standard of living adequate for the health and well-being of himself, from the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR),
Concerned	by the fact that numerous developing countries have an occupancy level that exceeds 150% and even reaches 600% for the Democratic Republic of the Congo, represent an amount that could hardly be corrected without international aid,
Congratulating	the countries that have respected the norms surrounding prison occupancy levels such as Russia, that is an example in this field by building the largest prison in all of Europe
Decides	<p>on the creation of an international high security penal institution in Siberia able to accommodate up to 100'000 inmates coming from the entire planet, and operated based on the Norwegian model that utilizes cognitive and behavioral therapy programs;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- to ask the UN a financial contribution to this project, as well as the attribution of an international status to the penal institution which will allow any inmates to be incarcerated regardless of their nationality;- to ask the collaboration of Amnesty International to conduct yearly assessments of the conditions of incarceration all over the world and inside the prison in order to have a follow up on our project- that the rest of the project be financed by the prisoners' country of origin; the financial distribution will be done equitably and the rate will be chosen based on the countries and the number of inmates that it decides to send in- that only the inmates serving a sentence over 10 years will be able to be incarcerated in this establishment upon the request of the state where the judgment was held.
