Concern Global approximation on sustainable and transparent supply chains.

The General Assembly,

Knowing that transparent supply chains are the first step to meet the major goals of the Action Platform on Decent Work in Global supply chains developed, by the UN Global Compact,

Observing that Turkmenistan is one of the countries suffering from the non-transparent supply chains, that violate environmental standards and damage the environment all over the world,

Concerned that all existing draft legislation and guiding principles are inadequate, to deal effectively with the problems of global supply chains,

Fearing that if things continue as they are, the many polluting supply chains will have a long-lasting negative impact on the environment and the people affected,

Demanding to encourage other countries to develop comprehensive and effective guiding principles for sustainable and transparent supply chains,

that the UN passes an international law which is legally anchored and obliges countries to control and monitor globally active companies more closely

that an international authority monitor compliance with environmental protection requirements and the associated observance of human rights.

that the UN provide financial support to countries that are victims of fundamental problems in supply chains and in this way counteract environmental pollution and the violation of human rights.
